POSITIVE BEHAVIOUR MANAGEMENT

We encourage positive behaviour management

- Praise good behaviour "I like the way you helped" or "that's great you're taking turns."
- Keep an eye out Supervise children and be ready to step in before problems arise.
- Help children to resolve conflict "what would be a better way?"
- Redirect to a more acceptable activity if necessary
- Help tamariki to express their feelings verbally
- Let your child know what you expect of them sharing toys, playing nicely etc.
- Please no smacking, put downs, or yelling
